The Gardendale Magnolia Festival scholarships are awarded to seniors only

If proceeds of Magnolia Festival allow, six \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to Gardendale High School students. Four additional \$1,000 scholarships will be open to students from Fultondale, Mortimer Jordan, Corner, Tabernacle Christian, and any home school student residing in these school zones. Students whose primary residence is in these zones but attend school at a school not listed above, such as the Shades Valley IB, will be considered. GHS students are not excluded from consideration of the additional 4 scholarships. If the top 6 applicants are from GHS, then 6 scholarships will be awarded to GHS students, but students from the other schools are only considered for the scholarships after first 6.
