- Scholarship Application must be *POSTMARKED WITH VISIBLE POSTMARK* BY MARCH 31.
- THERE IS NOT A DROP OFF LOCATION.
- It will not be accepted at any city building.
- Applicants must volunteer at least 3 hours before or during the festival. (Volunteer application is separate and emailed to separate address on that application.)
- **IMPORTANT: AFTER MAILING YOUR SCHOLARSHIP, YOU MUST EMAIL [GDALEMAGFEST@GMAIL.COM](mailto:gdalemagfest@gmail.com) THAT DAY TO LET US KNOW TO BE LOOKING FOR YOUR APPLICATION. THIS PREVENTS LOST APPLICATIONS**
If you do not receive a return email from us after 2 days of your email notification that we have received your application, call or text 205-913-053.
- The Gardendale Magnolia Festival scholarships are awarded to high school **seniors only** but students can **start volunteering** with the festival in 9th grade to accrue volunteer hours.
- Gardendale Magnolia Festival will award up to ten \$1,000 scholarships in **2026**. The scholarships are open to students from these schools: Gardendale, Fultondale, Mortimer Jordan, Corner, Tabernacle Christian, and any home school student residing in these school zones.
- Students whose primary residence is in these zones but attend school a school not listed above, such as the Shades Valley IB, will be considered.
- Do not include photos of student.
- Application must be completed by student, not parent.
